Facts about our “Littlest Horned Frogs”

- The KinderFrogs School at TCU is Tarrant County's *only* early intervention educational program for small children ages 18 months to 6 years old with Down syndrome and other developmental delays, as well as a small number of typically developing children.
- TCU's KinderFrogs School has earned accreditation from the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), the nation's leading organization of early childhood professionals. Currently, only 9% of early childhood education programs in the United States hold this accreditation.
- There is a class ratio of three children to every adult – maximizing attention and growth opportunities.
- The children at KinderFrogs School receive speech, physical, occupational, and music therapy during the school day.
- TCU students are an active and vital part of KinderFrogs as observers, practice teachers, classroom aides, and beginning educational researchers.
- Comprehensive assessment is offered to KinderFrogs students and shared with their families regularly.
- Annual tuition for 2018-19 is \$18,500, but significant financial assistance is available to families in need.
- More than 70% of KinderFrogs students rely on financial aid.
- The staff is highly trained and committed to quality preschool education for all children.
- The School continues to serve the community by reaching out to pregnant moms and families who have just learned they are expecting a child with Down syndrome.
- KinderFrogs' parents share their experiences and offer personal support to new parents facing the challenge of raising a child with developmental delays.
